

Membership Committee Report - December 14 2021

Searching for NAVRES Cadets

This quarter Russ and Roger of the 2023 Committee agreed to offer nominal and contact lists to each of the NRD liaison representatives when they decided individually to ask for one to organize local 2023 events. These lists include individuals known to have relocated to that community and area. To date, lists have been sent to Nonsuch, Tecumseh, Unicorn, Queen and Cataraqui.

As stated in the last report, the search for data on the No NRD List of 1969 -2020 former cadets has stalled - the main reason being the lack of further senior contacts and the lack of responses from many that have been approached. However, recent engagement with Naval Reserve Board and Naval Reserve Headquarters may provide us with more links across NRDs and other contacts.

Other Activities and Social Media Approaches

The UNTDA Facebook Group is now up to 162 members and continues to garner interest as more people become aware and join. Postings, comments and sharing of photos have also increased and more members of the group are engaging in more than reviewing and “liking” posts by adding comments and posts as well as engaging in discussions. Posts to remind members about assisting with the search for missing information on the nominal rolls and to check the UNTDA website for information on 2023 activities will be repeated at regular intervals.

Due to other priorities, the strategic engagement discussions on communications and combined efforts to enhance outreach and membership search have been postponed until the new year.
