

# UNTDA Archives Report - for December 13, 2022

## Nominal and In Memoriam List:

There have been no structural changes to the Master List in the last quarter. All active communication with the Contact List or its various subsets, continues to result in updates to our online lists. In the most recent quarter, Russ Cape's contacts at VENTURE produced the class lists for the last 6 years worth of MARS and NWO for Reservists, resulting in 145 names previously unknown to us.

In the calendar year 2020, 88 Members were known to have crossed the bar; 84 in 2021 and 60 so far in 2022.

## Contact List:

1,214 of which 972 (80.0%) have active, non-bouncing emails. Of those 972; 676 (70%) are UNTD, 297 (30%) are ROU TP+ There are 52 unresolved bounced emails which may or may not have valid phone/address information. 131 are Location only, that is, we know roughly where they are but no contact information exists. For various reasons, over time, 32 have requested no contact, which although we retain the information, we respect.

## VIP List:

There are 1,864 Citations for 774 UNTD and ROU TP+ Cadets. 1,632 (88%) are UNTD, 232 (12%) are ROU TP+. The ratio is unchanged over the last quarter.

## Military Units List:

305 operational military units in which NavRes Officer Cadets trained, served or commanded; all 3 Services, domestic and foreign. This is no significant change over the last quarter.

## Biographies:

Embedded as links in our online lists, are 3,108 Biographical profiles of varying depths.

## Active Members:

There are currently 281 "Active" (dues-paying) Members (2021 and beyond). 226 are UNTD (80%), 46 (16%) are ROU TP+, 9 are other (3%).

## Website Downloads:

There has been a noticeably higher number of file downloads from the Website in the last quarter. Files relating to the NavRes Centennial and the UNTDA Convention, top that list. The Centennial file has been mirrored elsewhere which could explain its higher numbers. Some of our larger files, such as the Yearbooks, have also seen abnormally higher downloads. So has Untidy Tales and History of STAR for instance. More recent files such as CSVC and AGM material have also been well downloaded.
