Graham Scott is President of Graham Scott Strategies Inc. He has extensive experience in public policy, governance and in the assessment of boards and management teams with a particular emphasis on health care.

He was Executive Assistant to the Rt. Hon. Robert Stanfield from 1970-1976 and held a number of posts in the Ontario Government including Assistant Deputy Attorney-General, Associate Secretary of Cabinet and Deputy Minister of Environment and Deputy Minister of Health.

Mr. Scott was a Partner at the law firm of McMillan LLP from 1984 until 2008 and served as Managing Partner from 2000-2006.

He has served as a mediator/facilitator between hospitals, hospital Foundations and physicians and has prepared confidential assessments of non-profit and profit-based Boards and management teams. . He has served as both a Supervisor of Hospitals and as a factfinder for the Ministry of Health in Ontario under provincial legislation.

He is the past President and Chair of The Naval Reserve Association of Canada/Association Reserve navale du Canada and prior to that served as President of the UNTD Association.

He currently serves as a Director of LDIC Inc, The Canadian Institute of Historical Education, the Atlantic Salmon Federation and, Rothesay Netherwood School.

He is the immediate past Chair of the Institute for Research on Public Policy and Canada Health Infoway. He is a past Chair of the Canadian Institute of Health Information and the Public Policy Forum.
